## Universal Offer for All

- High Quality First teaching available for all children.
- Regular, evidence-based CPL for teachers to enhance pedagogy.
- Training and support for Early Career Teachers.
- In-house peer coaching to develop teaching and learning.
- Trust specialist teaching and learning support with access to Flying High English Hub.
- A consistent lesson design structure for all lessons with a clear focus on reactivating prior learning, clear explanations, modelling, learning together, reflecting as well as purposeful task design to reinforce and consolidate learning.
- Opportunities for children to deepen their thinking in all lessons.
- Adaptations made to support all learners where appropriate.
- Purposeful and meaningful feedback to eradicate misconceptions and consolidate learning.
- Formative assessment to identify gaps so that teachers can amend lessons accordingly.
- Support from the inclusion team to identify barriers to attendance and provide effective strategies to support parents and carers.
- Reading is a priority in all classrooms as teachers understand that fostering a love of reading is key to developing rich vocabulary and language.

## Targeted Academic Support

- Small group interventions
- One-to-one interventions
- Evidence based intervention programs such as SHINE
- Regular and robust pupil progress meetings to identify children who need additional academic support.
- Individual learning plans detailing specific support for some children.

## Wider Strategies

- Opportunities for children to attend school residentials and trips to develop cultural capital.
- Access to a school family support worker to support with difficulties and challenges some of our parents face.
- Access to a range of enrichment activities that are subsidised to encourage pupil uptake.
- Access to wrap-around care via the school's before and afterschool clubs.
- Signposting to holiday clubs around the local area.
- Maths and Literacy skills sessions for parents to access so that they are able to support their children at home.
- Opportunities to access parenting sessions around a range of topics.
