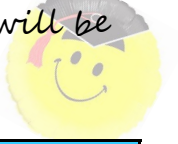

Reading

The children are expected to change their book regularly. This means reading one to two books a week.

Reading targets

Reading targets are set for your child to help accelerate their progress in reading. We work on their reading targets in guided and shared reading. Working on these targets at school and home will support children in knowing what they need to do to improve their reading. When your child has achieved their reading target please tick one of the small boxes beside it.
