Areas for action:

1. European Day of Languages/No Pens Day.
 - Children were asked to discuss their opinions regarding European Language Day/No Pens Day ready for the next meeting.

Feedback from Class Councils:

- KS2 children think it would be safer to just have 1 class on the trim trail at a time.
- KS2 children think the trim trail should be opened at lunch time, and have a two weekly time table. For example: Week 1: Monday break time: 3KG, Monday lunch time: 3SM. Week 2: Monday break time: 3SM, Monday lunch time: 3KG.
- KS2 thought that if the above were to happen, then a timetable could be stuck onto the fence next to the trim trail to avoid any confusion.
- Children thought it would be a good idea to have a coned off 'chill out zone', where no running is allowed. They expressed an interest in having chalk to draw on the playground in this area.
- Children felt they needed more equipment (skipping ropes, balls etc.) at lunch time, to avoid arguments regarding who gets to use the equipment.
- Children in both KS1 and KS2 would like to have coned off areas for activities such as: skipping, NED zone, football, chalking etc.
- Year 6 expressed that they think it would be a good idea if some of the year sixes were play leaders and organised games for the rest of the school (KS1 and KS2), such as football, skipping etc.
- KS1 expressed an interest in having 'tidy up monitors' to help tidy up the playground at the end of play/lunch time. KS2 agreed that this would be a good idea.
- KS2 thought it would be a good idea to have the opportunity to run the mile during lunch time.
