### Feedback from Class Councils:

- KS1 children enjoyed the opportunity to work with a variety of teachers in a variety of classrooms. KS2 children also enjoyed this opportunity, but suggested it could be better if they were able to spread across all of the phases, instead of staying in their own phase.
- All children enjoyed the wide range of learning they experienced throughout the day, and generally felt there was a brilliant range of learning opportunities. Some children in KS2 suggested that the day could have been better if the children had more input on the chosen activities.
- All children enjoyed the opportunity to show what they'd learnt during the assembly at the end of the day, and felt proud of what they'd achieved throughout the day.
- KS2 children really enjoyed the concept of learning without pens, and emphasised the enjoyment they experienced in presenting their ideas in a variety of different ways.
- KS1 really enjoyed being active throughout the day (they particularly enjoyed the Irish dancing!).
- KS2 children expressed they felt it would be better if No Pens Day and European Language Day were two separate days, in order to focus on one day at a time.
