Areas for action:

1. Reading

- Children have been asked to speak to their classes about reading across the school. Discussions should be based around: the reading areas around school and how they could be improved, our library books, our homework reading books, and any other ideas the children have about reading within the school (author visits etc).

- KS2 children suggested that healthy snacks were available to buy during break times.

- KS1 children suggested that there is a new trim trail built on the KS1 playground, or that the old climbing frame is knocked down and new things are painted onto the playground.
- KS1 children suggested that every class should reward their 'Dojo Champion' in the same way each week.
- All children thought it would be a good idea if ABC time was extended and not restricted to their phases, as this would allow them to have more choice in the activities they could choose.
