Feedback from Class Councils:

- KS1 and KS2 children suggested that it would be a nice idea to do a 'book swap'. Children could bring in a book from home and swap it with another child.
- KS2 children suggested that we could have a 'book swap station' where the current 'Polar Explorer' display is.
- KS2 suggested that the library could be opened up during the lunch hour for children to read in. They felt that this might help the children who don't like going outside.
- Upper KS2 suggested an after school 'reading club'. They suggested that this could entail the older children reading to the younger children or just reading independently. They felt this could take place in the library, 2/3 times a week.
- All of the children thought it would be a good idea if the older children came down to read with the younger children 2/3 times a week at the end of the day, instead of the teacher reading them a story.
- KS2 thought it would be a great idea to have reading as an option during ABC time, especially if there were comics to read.
- KS1/KS2 thought it would be a good idea if children were given the option to read during the lunch hour. They felt that this could count towards their ABC time.
- All children thought it would be a good idea to have regular assemblies with teachers and children highlighting their 'book recommendations' and the reasons for them.
- All children thought it would be a good idea to send some invites out to authors inviting them to come and visit us and read us some of their stories.
